In addition to the completion of the general requirements of a business practice the respective practice and/or qualification examination certificates must be fulfilled for a self-employed occupation. Additional information:

Access: successful attendance of an agricultural and/or nutrition economic vocational school of at least three years.

Duration of education: 3 years

Duration of company work placements: 4 weeks in all

Education objectives: Intensive three-year vocational education in general educational, specific-theoretical and specific-practical agricultural, viticulture and pomiculture economic and business subjects. Imparting methods, competences and attitudes that enable the students to direct exercise vocations of a higher level in the areas of agriculture, viticulture and pomiculture or in allied fields as well as for studies at a university. Further important goals are: skills of vocational mobility and flexibility, creativity, criticism, social and personal competences, learning competence, social engagement, ability to communicate in the mother tongue and in foreign languages.
